

Question 2

mean > median > mode

Question 3

- (i) Explain what is meant by a sampling frame?
- (ii) Give the name of a sampling method that does not require a sampling frame.

Question 4

In a school are 254 boys and 172 girls.

The Head Teacher wishes to inspect the work of 40 pupils, and decides to take a stratified sample.

How many of each gender should the Head Teacher inspect?

Question 5

In a supermarket, the time it takes, in minutes, for ten customers to serve themselves at a self-service checkout is recorded

Find the median

Ten Springer Spaniels are weighed, in kg.

- (iii) the standard deviation, σ

Question 10

A biologist is investigating how many eggs the osprey lays in each brood cycle. The results are given in this frequency table.

N° of eggs	1	2	3	4
Frequency	25	21	X	5

If the mean number of eggs is 2, find the value of x

Question 11The heights of a year group of children were measured.

Height (cm)	Frequency	Mid-Interval
135 - 144	20	139.5
145 - 149	42	147
150 - 154	86	152
155 - 159	58	157
160 - 174	10	167

Use linear interpolation to determine the median height.

Question 16

Ten students take a spelling test

Their scores, s, are such that

$$\Sigma s = 247 \qquad \qquad \Sigma s^2 = 6302$$

Work out the standard deviation for the students scores.

Here are the maximum daily temperatures, in °C, recorded in a city in October

18 14 12 16 8 15 127 16 14 10

If you were asked to 'clean the data' what would you do?

Question 18

Some data are collected.

The lower quartile is 46 and the upper quartile is 68.

An outlier is an observation that falls $1.5 \times$ (interquartile range) either above the upper quartile or below the lower quartile.

Show how to use this rule to determine if 11 is an outlier or not.

Question 19

State whether each of the following is qualitative or quantitative

- (i) The colour of a person's shoes
- (ii) The size of a person's shoes

A researcher wishes to know peoples view on BREXIT.

She stands outside a supermarket with the aim of asking people what they think.

Before she starts, she has decided to ask ten people under the age of 30, ten people between 30 and 50, and ten people over 50.

What type of sampling is this?

Question 21

For a set of 10 numbers;

$$\sum x = 50 \qquad \qquad \sum x^2 = 310$$

For a different set of 15 numbers

$$\sum x = 86 \qquad \qquad \sum x^2 = 568$$

Find the mean and the standard deviation of the combined set of 25 numbers
